



Petkim's Position on Climate-Related Public Policy and Regulation

Petkim supports the development of climate-related public policy in Türkiye and actively contributes to it rather than obstructing it. We support Türkiye's 2053 Net Zero target and the Green Deal Action Plan, and we take these national objectives into account in our own decarbonization planning and investment decisions.

We support carbon pricing as an effective instrument for reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Petkim participates in workshops convened by the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change on the design of the Turkish Emissions Trading System (T-ETS), contributing operational and sectoral input to the development of the scheme. We do not engage in any advocacy opposing carbon pricing or climate regulation.

Board Oversight of Climate Change Risks by Named Position

Ömür Önk, SOCAR Türkiye's Chief Strategy and Sustainability, oversees the sustainability and climate change related issues across all SOCAR Türkiye group companies, including Petkim. He also sits on Petkim's Board of Directors.

Petkim serves as a Board Member of the Turkish Chemical Manufacturers Association (TKSD), the principal representative body of the Turkish chemical industry and the national counterpart of Cefic (the European Chemical Industry Council). Through its Board-level role, Petkim contributes to and acts in alignment with TKSD's positions on climate change and the sector's low-carbon transition. Petkim's decarbonization practices are pursued consistently with the climate positions advanced by TKSD on behalf of the sector.

Turkish Wind Energy Association (TÜREB)

Petkim is a member of the Turkish Wind Energy Association (TÜREB), an association dedicated to the expansion of wind energy and the decarbonization of Türkiye's electricity supply. Petkim's membership reflects and is consistent with its commitment to increasing the share of renewable energy in its operations and reducing the carbon intensity of its energy consumption.

Petkim's climate change policy and commitments are consistent with the positions of the trade associations of which we are a member. We have reviewed the publicly stated climate positions of our principal industry memberships and identified no area of disagreement or material misalignment with our own climate policy.

For example, we sit on the Board of the Turkish Chemical Manufacturers Association (TKSD), where the agenda centres on the chemical sector's low-carbon transition, energy efficiency and decarbonization - all of which we support and help shape. In addition, we are also a member of the Turkish Wind Energy Association (TÜREB), whose work to expand renewable capacity and decarbonize Türkiye's electricity supply sits squarely alongside our own commitment to increasing the renewable share of our energy use. We are not aware of any climate position taken by either association that is weaker than our own.
