



Our Social Responsibility Approach

Petkim and its SOCAR Türkiye Group Companies operate in full alignment with corporate and governance principles and a strict code of ethical business conduct. Within this framework, Petkim does not provide any financial contributions to political parties, political campaigns, candidates, or lobbying activities. This approach reflects Petkim’s commitment to neutrality and transparency in government policy engagement.

Accordingly, Petkim confirms that it did not make any contributions or have any expenditures for political campaigns, political organizations, or lobbyists in 2025. However, Petkim makes payments in the form of membership fees to Chambers of Commerce and Industry and non-governmental organizations, which do not support political lobbying or policy influence activities.

This approach reflects Petkim’s commitment to neutrality and transparency in government policy engagement.

As of 2025, all payments made under this scope are limited to annual membership fees paid to Chambers of Commerce and Industry and non-governmental organizations. These payments are carried out as part of Petkim’s institutional activities aimed at fostering sustainable and constructive stakeholder relationships, strengthening sectoral representation, and contributing to collective value creation.

In this context, the total amount of payments made to Chambers of Commerce and Industry and NGOs in 2025 amounted to **9,366,246.23 TRY**. Petkim does not engage in or financially support any political or lobbying activities. Instead, in line with its sustainability priorities, Petkim continues to deliver high-impact contributions through corporate social responsibility practices that are centered on long-term societal value creation.

Petkim’s key contributions in 2025 focused on creating social value across priority areas including community development, education, healthcare, environment, and local capacity building. These initiatives primarily aim to support women’s entrepreneurship, enhance educational infrastructure, strengthen healthcare services, preserve biodiversity, and improve local service capabilities.

Notable contributions include the “*Women Empowerment in Entrepreneurship*” program, sapling donations under the Petkim 60th Anniversary Memorial Forest initiative, school renovation projects carried out in cooperation with the İzmir Provincial Directorate of National Education, medical equipment support provided to Aliğa State Hospital, and vehicle donations aimed at strengthening the operational capacity of local municipalities. In this context, the total contribution amount allocated to selected high-impact projects in 2025 reached **250,139 USD**.



These contributions are implemented in full alignment with Petkim’s sustainability priorities, particularly in fostering inclusive growth, enhancing access to quality education, strengthening healthcare services, promoting environmental awareness, and supporting local development. When assessed together with the membership-based contributions, it is evident that Petkim’s stakeholder engagement model extends beyond representation and membership structures, evolving into a holistic value creation approach supported by tangible and high-impact social investments.

Within this, Petkim does not provide any financial contributions to political parties, political campaigns, or lobbying activities, and conducts all interactions with government institutions, chambers of commerce and industry, professional organizations, and non-governmental organizations in alignment with its sustainability priorities.

This approach is overseen within a governance framework with defined roles and responsibilities, including oversight at executive management level, ensuring that public policy engagement is conducted in line with Petkim's sustainability commitments.

Through its memberships in Chambers of Commerce and Industry as well as industry and business associations, Petkim actively participates in representation activities that prioritize environmental compliance, energy efficiency, circular economy practices, local development, and social inclusion. These engagements serve as a platform to promote responsible sectoral development while ensuring alignment with evolving regulatory and sustainability frameworks. In managing these relationships, Petkim adopts an approach that is guided by international best practices and aligned with the objectives of the Paris Agreement. In cases of potential misalignment, Petkim evaluates the relevant positions within these platforms and undertakes necessary reviews to ensure continued alignment with its sustainability commitments.

Petkim has established a structured review and monitoring process to assess whether its public policy engagements and the activities of trade associations are aligned with the Paris Agreement. This process includes periodic evaluations of trade association positions and activities.

When considered together with the membership-related contributions the social investment initiatives, this approach demonstrates that Petkim's stakeholder engagement model goes beyond representation and membership structures, evolving into a holistic value creation framework supported by tangible, impact-driven sustainability contributions.
